

Overview of free PCR tests, etc.

- Efforts to confirm vaccination history and negative test results, to encourage the use of all test subjects, etc., and to popularize the test , asymptomatic third vaccination unfinished persons, all test subjects, etc., economic society Free tests (in principle, qualitative antigen tests) required for activities .
- If there is a tendency for the spread of infection, the prefectural governor will make PCR tests free of charge for a wide range of reasons such as anxiety about infection. In principle, it is carried out at level 2 (level where alertness should be strengthened) or higher.

Vaccine inspection package / establishment promotion project such as inspection for all subjects (**inspection target / method**)

method) y "Vaccine / inspection" in conducting economic and social activities

Free of charge for the "package system" or "test for all subjects" and the tests necessary for efforts by local governments and private businesses to confirm vaccination history and negative test results.

General inspection business when infection is spreading

(**Inspection target / method**) • In addition to the items on the left, if the prefectural governor requests that "asymptomatic persons who feel anxious should undergo an inspection" based on Article 24, Paragraph 9 of the Special Measures Law, the residents will respond accordingly. 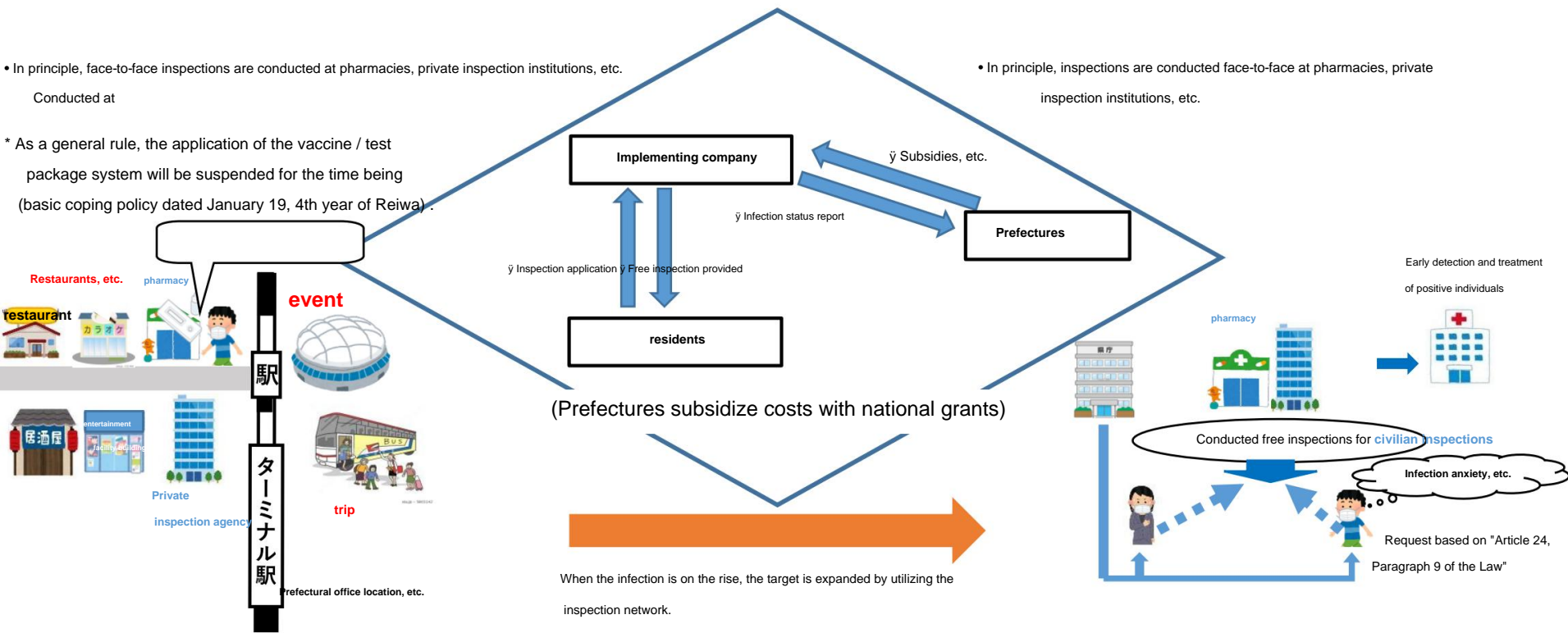
• In principle, face-to-face inspections are conducted at pharmacies, private inspection institutions, etc.
